Fully vaccinated-individuals (aged 12 years old and above) just need to present a Vaccination Certificate via VaxCertPH; a locally issued Vaccination ID with fully vaccinated status and verifiable QR Code. Minors aged 11 years old and below, who are traveling with vaccinated adults are not required to present a Vaccination ID or certificate nor are they required to undergo an RT-PCR Swab or Saliva Test. However, non-vaccinated travelers aged 12 years old and above need to undergo an RT-PCR test taken 72 hours prior to their flight to Boracay.

Travelers to Boracay only need to follow two simple steps after booking their flight and stay at Discovery Shores Boracay. First is to secure an Online Health Declaration QR Code at https://touristboracay.com and save an electronic copy (via their mobile phone) or printed copy of the QR Code and Health Declaration Form (HDC) confirmation page. Second is to email copies of the five required documents to touristboracay@gmail.com with the email subject: OHDC-Family Name, First Name. These requirements include a copy of (1) the Health Declaration Form (HDC), (2) the Vaccination Certificate or Vaccination ID (if fully-vaccinated) or the Negative RT-PCR Test Result (if not vaccinated), (3) a copy of Booking Confirmation from the hotel, (4) a valid ID with a Philippine address and (5) a copy of your roundtrip flight or travel details.

Even with the decrease in the new Covid-19 cases in the country, Discovery Shores Boracay consistently been following their heightened sanitation protocols in all areas of the resort operations so that guests can fully enjoy a beautiful, worry-free stay.
